WHAT IS THE CERS SANDBOX?

The CERS sandbox is a training tool intended to help local educational agency (LEA) staff learn about the features and functions of the California Educator Reporting System (CERS) in a non-secure environment. It offers users virtually the same functions as CERS, but uses practice test items and fictitious student data.

HOW DO USERS ACCESS THE SANDBOX?

Because the sandbox does not contain any secure information, login credentials are not needed to access it. Users simply select a role such as teacher, school administrator, or district administrator to enter the sandbox to view it from the perspective of that role.
