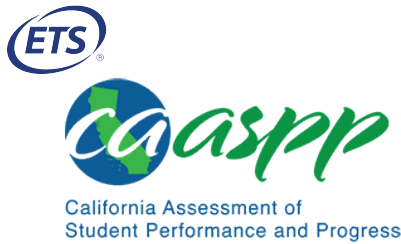

**Subject:** CAASPP and ELPAC: Current Updates to Supported Operating Systems and Browsers for 2020-21



Dear LEA CAASPP Coordinator, LEA ELPAC Coordinator, or Technology Coordinator:

Operating systems and browsers supported for 2020–2021 CAASPP and ELPAC online testing will be updated as of June 29, 2020. These technology requirements also will include the computer-based Initial ELPAC, which is available beginning August 20, 2020.

As of June 29, only the operating systems listed on the [Secure Browsers](#) web page are supported for testing.

The desktop secure browser version 12.5 (Windows, MacOS, Linux) is required for all CAASPP and ELPAC computer-based test administration.

The tables that follow list the changes in supported operating systems, browsers, and associated software that are supported for 2020–2021 testing.
